Police: Man choked girlfriend after she doesn't sign over house

ORLANDO - An Orlando man was arrested and charged with attempted murder early Saturday after authorities said he choked his girlfriend because she wouldn't sign over the deed to her house.

The woman told police that Darryl Wallington, her boyfriend of six years, had come home from work angry and demanded she sign the deed of their house over to him. When she refused, the report said, he choked her so hard that blood vessels in one of her eyes ruptured. He then told her he was going to take their daughter and flee the state, but later allowed the victim to leave the house, according to an arrest affidavit.

He was held without bail at the Orange County Jail.
